Operates equipment to enlarge and bind materials for visually impaired students. Operates equipment, develops procedures to make tactile graphs, maps, or raised line drawings. Prepares and processes Federal Quota orders and materials. Provides support/training in computerized technology adaptations for visually impaired students.
