1. Is JCPS requiring on-site visits or is it preferred for work to be conducted remotely?

JCPS is not requiring on-site visits, nor is it preferred for the work to be conducted remotely. The service provider has the autonomy to select the combination of on-site and / or remote work to meet the project objectives.

2. What is JCPS budget for this project?

The service provider should create a budget and bid they feel is appropriate to cover the services and resources needed to address the Scope of Work.

4. Does JCPS anticipate that the selected provider will include interviews/survey with parents and the community? If so, how will these be identified to the provider?

JCPS anticipates that the service provider will solicit stakeholder, including but not limited to parents and community) input. Any survey used would need Internal Review Board (IRB) approval. If surveys / interviews will be the method selected by the service provider, JCPS has the resources to distribute the survey(s) by way of email. The ability to identify specific parents / community stakeholders would depend on the criteria for identification.

5. Is JCPS requiring that transportation professionals be a part of the providers team?
